 - a. Revelation of G-d's existence
 - b. Revelation of His Unity
 - c. Revelation of His Authority
- The unwritten plan of G-d that is written on (in) the Cosmos.
- The synchronicity of the Cosmos with billions of things moving, dancing their way through time.
- Each thing influencing one another pushing and pulling their motion and path.
- This plan is so deeply seated in the Cosmos that we do not see it. But everything from the people around you, the places where you shop, the groceries you buy, the yard you mow, the mower you use.
- The place where you study, who you study with etc.
