## Algorithm for NC interpretation

- 1. Torah is the strict basis for all understanding of G-d (Research)
- 2. The Torah is the strict basis for all understanding of G-d's will for the Jewish people
- 3. The Torah is the strict basis for all understanding of G-d's will for all humanity
- 4. The term "Torah" referrers to writings of the Torah itself and the interpretation of the Sages and Torah Scholars (legitimate)
- 5. No statement from the NC can invalidate any principle, saying or interpretation of the Jewish Sages and Torah Scholars concerning the Torah.
- 6. The veracity of any phrase, pericope chapter, book, or verse in the NC can only be valid and validated if it agrees with or by the Torah
- 7. The Hermeneutic Rules, 7—Hillel, 13— Yishmael, 32—Agadah and 42—So'od are the basis for exegesis of all outside literature.
- 8. All rules of language and grammar apply to the Hermeneutic Genre of interpretation and exegesis.
- 9. The meaning of any given text should be read and interpreted from Hebrew. (Biblical)
- 10. All translations, commentaries and exegesis concerning the NC must agree with the principle that Yeshua is Messiah and we are therefore committed to his place as a son of G-d.
- 11. These translations, commentaries and exegesis must not deify Yeshua in any way. Thus, we deny the teachings that Yeshua is a part of the "Trinity."
- 12. Any note, translation or comment must not have any anti-Semitic tone or insinuation.
